

Southeastern Louisiana University Admissions Criteria for Beginning Freshmen

Louisiana High School Applicants

Completion of Board of Regents High School Core Curriculum	4 units of English, Math, Science, Social Studies, 2 units of Foreign Language & 1 unit of Art
No more than one developmental course needed	Must have ACT Math score of 19 or higher OR Must have ACT English score of 18 or higher
Cumulative GPA	2.35 or above on a 4.0 scale
One of the following criteria	ACT composite score of at least 21 OR a core GPA of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale

Out-of-state Applicants

Option 1	Complete the same requirements as a Louisiana high school applicant
Option 2	At least 17 of the 19 units of the Louisiana Board of Regents High School Core Curriculum, no more than one developmental course needed, min cum GPA of a 2.35 and core GPA of 2.0, and ACT composite score of at least 21.
Option 3	Have an ACT composite of at least a 23 & no more than one developmental course needed.

Home School Program & GED Applicants

No more than one developmental course needed	Must have ACT Math score of 19 or higher OR Must have ACT English score of 18 or higher
ACT	Composite score of at least 23
